

Conditions of Entry

Please read before completing the Entry Form

1. Entrant

All entrants **must be** members of an MCPF member club.

2. Entries

It is recommended the images are cropped to a final size of not less than 1400 x 1050 pixels, entries that have previously been created at 1028 x 768 pixels are still eligible for entry, however they may project with a smaller image size. Please ensure that the 'Fullscreen' and 'Hide mouse cursor during show' are activated. Depending upon which version of PTE you are using, 'Size of Slide' should read 1400 x 1050 pixels

The entrant must submit a CD containing an .EXE programme, ie. the sequence must run with no additional software requirements. There should be only one sequence per CD, which should be indelibly labelled. The sequence should be programmed without a 'run box', and should return to the desktop at the end.

Your entry **must be** with Peter Brown by Saturday January 8th 2011.

3. General

The duration of a sequence must not exceed 12 minutes. A maximum of two sequences per author may be entered. The ruling excluding credits being screened has been rescinded.

4. Eligibility

Sequences entered and shown in any previous MidPhot AV, New Horizons AV Competition or Midlands Counties Slide/Tape or Digital AV Competition, may **not** be re-entered subsequently.

5. Copyright

It is the entrant's own responsibility to ensure that any material recorded on the Soundtrack or Visually shown is suitably covered against copyright infringement.

6. Projection of Entries

A Digital projector with a resolution of 1400 x 1050px, computer and sound system will be provided. All entries will be downloaded on to the computer's hard drive for projection, and will then be erased following the judging session. However for those selected to be shown at MidPhot Exhibition in March, a programme will be created and written to a CD for the exhibition organisers' use only.

7. Entry Form and Fee

An entry form must be completed for each sequence entered, and submitted together with the fee £7.00 per entry. Closing date for entries is Saturday January 8th.

8. MidPhot Exhibition

A selection of sequences will be chosen by the judges to be shown at MidPhot exhibition during March.

9. Conditions of Entry

The submission of a completed entry form implies the acceptance of these 'Conditions of Entry'.

The author of the sequence receiving the most votes will be awarded
